**The Large Commercial Yacht Code (LY3 Code), Chapter 30** requires all yachts to operate a Safety Management System, yachts of 500GT and over will comply with the IMO's International Safety Management **ISM Code**. The **ISM Code** places an obligation on owners and managers to provide a safe environment onboard.

Life Saving Appliances and Fire Fighting equipment are required to be identified by signage. Risk assessment identifies the hazards associated with operations and life onboard ship. Hazards that cannot be fully eradicated must be identified; warning, prohibition and mandatory signs provide a control measure where a hazard cannot otherwise be removed.

Maritime Progress Photoluminescent signs are also now available as standard in sizes to complement the 50x50mm IMO symbol signs, originally developed for use onboard large yachts.
